### **Part-Time Contract: Appellate Judge**

**The Flandreau Santee Sioux Tribe is accepting application/resumes for a Part Time Contract Appellate Judge.**

**Summary:** The Flandreau Santee Sioux Tribe (the “Tribe”), located in Flandreau, South Dakota, is seeking applicants for the part-time position of Appellate Judge of its Court of Appeals. The Appellate Judge, under the direction of the Chief Appellate Judge, will be tasked with the responsibility of fulfilling the judicial role identified within the Tribe’s Constitution.

**Education and Experience:** Applicant must be a licensed attorney in good standing with the State Bar of South Dakota, or any other state bar, and is able to be admitted in South Dakota within 10 months of employment. Must have between ten years of experience as a practicing attorney, with experience in Indian Law and Criminal Law. Must have a juris doctorate from an American Bar Association accredited law school. No felony or misdemeanor convictions involving a crime of moral turpitude. Applicant must pass a pre-employment drug/alcohol screening, PL101-630 Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act adjudicated background investigation and maintain a valid SD driver’s license.

Must submit to a P.L. 101-630 background check and pre-employment drug and alcohol screening.

Preference in filing vacancies is given to **qualified** Indian candidates in accordance with Indian Preference Act of 1934 (Title 25, USC, Section 472). Verification must be submitted with the application if claiming Indian Preference. Consideration will be given to non-Indian applicants in the absence of qualified Indian Preference eligible.
