Reminder that children typically need updated vaccinations at kindergarten, 6th grade, and age 16.

SHOTS before SCHOOL!



### **Kindergarten Vaccination Requirements**

Four or more doses of **diphtheria**, **tetanus**, **and pertussis** (**DTaP**) **vaccine**, at least one dose on or after age 4.

Four or more doses of **poliovirus vaccine**, at least one dose on or after age 4.

Two doses of a **measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine.** (MMR). Minimum age for the first dose is 12 months.

Two doses of **varicella (chickenpox) vaccine**. Minimum age for the first dose is 12 months. History of disease is acceptable with parent or guardian signature.



### NOTE

Although not required for school entry, Hib, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Influenza, and Pneumococcal vaccines are also recommended for your kindergartener.

### **6th Grade Immunizations:**

**Tdap\*** (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)

MCV4\* (Meningococcal)

**HPV** (Human Papillomavirus)

**Flu** (Influenza)

VACCINATE YOUR 11-12 YEAR OLDS

\*School entry REQUIREMENT for South Dakota 6th grade students.

For more information, talk with your family physician or community health nurse about these and other vaccinations your preteen should receive.




