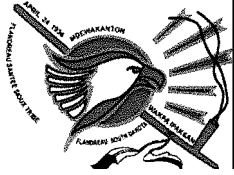

**Native Vision Scholarship**

Award: Unlisted

Eligibility: Member of a Federally Recognized tribe; Minimum 3.0 GPA; admitted to accredited community college or 4-year undergraduate program

Deadline: May 15, 2026

Notes: Awards two scholarships to Native youth entering their first year of college in the Fall each year

**American Indian College Fund-Full Circle Scholarship Program**

Award: Varies

Website: <http://www.collegefund.org>

Eligibility: Enrolled tribal member or descendent of enrolled parent/grandparent. Full-time; Minimum 2.0 GPA

Deadline: Opens January 1<sup>st</sup> and closes May 31<sup>st</sup> each year

Notes: Website contains numerous other scholarships lists and opportunities; including *A/CF-Tribal College Scholarship* and scholarship for Graduate students that include different requirements and deadlines. Generally does not fund private for profit colleges and universities. Must be accredited public or private college/university.

**Native Forward**

Award: \$1000-\$5000

Eligibility: Graduate Students

Deadline: Last remaining scholarships generally close early June 2026.

Notes: Website includes other field specific scholarships and loan for service opportunities for undergraduate or graduate students.

**Cobell Scholarship**

Award: Varies

Eligibility: Enrolled tribal member seeking a higher education degree (certificate, bachelors, masters or doctoral); full-time student

Deadline: March 31, 2026

Notes: This is both a merit and need-based competitive scholarship, annual and non-renewable (must re-apply each year)

**Theresa A. Mike Scholarship**

Award: \$500-\$5000

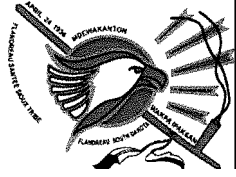

Eligibility: Enrolled member of a Federally Recognized Native American Tribe

Deadline: Doesn't specify, but transcripts must be received by June 30, 2026.

Notes: Letters of recommendation must be within the last six months.

**American Indian Services-College**

**Award: Unlisted**

**Eligibility:** Enrolled in an accredited university, college, or junior college, an enrolled member of a US Federally recognized American Indian or Alaska Native Tribe/Entity or a direct descendant of a base roll member, undergraduate with no more than 150-semester credits or 210 quarter credits, first bachelor's degree, graduate studies NOT eligible, Full or part time status, Minimum GPA of 2.25 must be established and maintained after the first semester/quarter of college, complete FAFSA.

**Deadline:** July 1<sup>st</sup> for September Award, November 1 for January Award

**Notes:** Unofficial transcripts are accepted. High school or GED transcripts are acceptable for incoming freshmen in their first two terms only. See required documents.

**American Indian Services – Trade School**

**Award: Unlisted**

**Website:** [Trade School Scholarships | American Indian Services](#)

**Eligibility:** Enrolled or will be enrolled in an accredited technical/trade school (incoming first-time trade applicant accepted). School must be accredited, enrolled member of US Federally Recognized American Indian or Alaska Native Tribe/Entity or direct descendant of a base roll member, high school graduate or GED, full or part time status, minimum cumulative GPA 2.25 must be established and maintained after the first term of the trade school program

**Deadline:** July 1<sup>st</sup> for September Award, November 1<sup>st</sup> for January Award

**Notes:** Transcript can be unofficial. See required documents.

**American Indigenous Science and Engineering Society**

**Award: Varies**

**Eligibility:** Must be a current AISES membership (membership is free for students), must be in a STEM field, must be a full-time student (12 credit hours or more), enrollment at an accredited college/university

**Deadline:** Deadlines and requirements may vary by scholarship

**Notes:** This website leads to a variety of available scholarships

**Indigenous Food and Agriculture and Agriculture Initiative**

**Award: Varies**
